HOW TO ENROL

Parents and carers are to provide **student identity** documents and meet the **100-point residential address check** at the time of submitting an online application.

This ensures that applications can be reviewed and processed at our school **within 14 days** of your online application.

YOUR ENROLMENT CHECKLIST

Before applying to enrol, make sure you:

- **Read** and understand our Enrolment Requirements for placement at Turramurra High School:
 - ✓ complete an Expression of Interest (Year 7 2025 only) digital applications close 31st March
 - ✓ complete a full online enrolment application
 - ✓ provide student identification Birth Certificate and/or Passport and Visa
 - ✓ meet the 100-point residential address check
 - ✓ 100-points residential proof must be current and show the full name of the student's parent/s and residential address
 - ✓ further information can be found on our website under <u>Enrolments</u>
- **Complete** a full <u>Online enrolment</u> application and include:
 - ✓ child's first enrolment date
 - ✓ two emergency contacts other than parent and over the age 18
 - ✓ health details or medical conditions, including medication name, dosage, and expiry date
 - ✓ a Special Religious Education (SRE) class your child will attend
 - ✓ Permission to Publish and Online Services
- **Upload** all documents to your Online enrolment:
 - ✓ <u>100-point residential address check</u>
 - ✓ child's Birth Certificate and/or Passport and Visa
 - ✓ child's Australian Passport or Citizenship documents *if both parents were born overseas*
 - ✓ medical plans, ASCIA Action Plans and/or Asthma Action Plans, *if applicable*
 - ✓ reports or plans to support your child's learning at our school, *if applicable*
