<b>Location</b>	NSW State Library (1 Shakespeare Pl, Sydney NSW 2000)
<b>Purpose</b>	History Extension Course Seminar - Focusing on The History Project, this experience will equip students with the tools, advice and confidence to embark on their major project. Attendees will have the opportunity to engage with speakers and panelists through an online Q&A.
<b>Start time</b>	8:00am Turrumurra Railway Station
<b>End time</b>	2:30pm Students will be released from the venue to make their own way home.
<b>Transport</b>	Students are to meet their teacher at Turrumurra Station at 8 am. They will then make their way to Martin Place station and walk to the State Library. Students will be making their own way home from the venue - the seminar is scheduled to finish at 2:30 pm.
