As a group they will travel by train and ferry to Taronga and return to Turrumurra Station where they will be dismissed. The excursion fee is for Zoo entry for THS students. Japanese exchange students will have their zoo ticket covered by THS. THS students will need their youth opal card to pay for travel. Japanese exchange students will need to use the Opal card issued to them.
