Additional information	*Due to COVID-19 and the rules of NSW Health, all groups visiting the National Park must be no more than 50 attendees (Educational activities included). Students who are seen as a danger to self and others or with little self regulation will not be permitted to attend. **Swimming activities will be supervised by privately run groups at their activities and by a Teacher with Surf Life Saving Awards such as the the Bronze Medallion in other times.
