The school's annual swimming carnival will be held at the Ku-ring-gai Fitness and Aquatic Centre, Lofberg Road, West Pymble, on Wednesday 3 February 2021.

The cost for the carnival is included in your 2021 school fees. It is an **official school day** and students are encouraged to attend and participate.

Due to COVID restrictions only Year 7 and serious competitors will be attending this year.

If it is wet on the morning of the carnival, a decision as to whether the carnival will run for all students will be made by 7:30am and a message communicated via student email, THS website, THS Facebook and School Stream. A 'competitors only' carnival will take place for those students wishing to qualify for zone. All other students will attend school as normal.

Please make sure your child has the appropriate protection from the elements (wet or fine). If it is a fine day (which we hope it is), sunscreen, a hat and plenty of water are essential. Students are to wear their Sport/PE uniform or House colours. *It is not a mufti day.*

All students will catch the bus from school at 8:45am under the supervision of teachers. All students need to meet at the amphitheatre at 8:40am. The water activities section must be completed for all students.

Please ensure that all information is returned to the front office by **Tuesday 2 February 2021.**

When the carnival is finished at approximately 2:15pm, buses will take students back to school in time to link up with the normal after school buses.
