Excursion / Incursion	YR10 Elective History Museum Tour
Date	Tuesday 6th December 2022 (Students will meet teachers near the end of Period 2 (10.40am) at THS MPC. Catching 10.50am-11.11am(572 Bus) to Turrumurra Station. Catching Train to Circular Quay Station (11.33am-12.15pm). 3 minute walk to museum. Students will be dismissed at the end of the excursion to make their own way home.)
Year / classes involved	Year 10 Elective History
Location	Justice and Police Museum (Cnr Phillip St &, Albert St, Sydney NSW 2000)
Purpose	<p>This challenging and thought-provoking program develops students' skills in historical research and critical thinking, and their appreciation of history as a study of human experience. Students are asked to investigate, as historians, this infamous event, examining evidence from various primary and secondary sources. They watch a film made in 1939, which outlines the facts of the case as they were understood at that time. Then, using other documentary evidence, students evaluate the film's reliability as a source for their inquiries and discuss perspectives presented by the media of the time. Students explore, examine and evaluate artefacts and documents relating to the case (including forensic evidence found during the criminal investigation), learning how a wide range of sources provides the evidence required to pursue a historical inquiry.</p> <p>https://sydneylivingmuseums.com.au/learning/programs/pyjama-girl-murder-case-study</p>
