Date	Monday 6th February 2023 (The 200 metre events will start on 8.30am. Main carnival events will start around 9.30am once the buses arrive from school.)

Purpose	The school's annual swimming carnival is on Monday 06/02/2023

Transport	Buses will be provided to transport students to and from the carnival, departing at 8:40 am and returning to school before the end of the day. Students wishing to compete in the long distance races will need to make their own way to the carnival. Parents who wish to drop off and/or pick up their child, MUST complete the relevant section on the consent form. Students without this permission will catch the bus to and from school.
Cost	The cost of the carnival is included in 2023 school fees.
Dress requirements	Full sports/PE uniform or House colours. It is not a mufti day.
Food	Students bring their own recess/lunch. Please bring plenty of water.
