| TECHNOLOGY – Industrial Arts | For the first two weeks of Term 4 in Industrial Arts, students will be given the opportunity to investigate an influential Indigenous Designer. Students will develop a presentation on the designer and produce a museum artefact that is influenced by the designer's work. | Week 2 - Indigenous Designer presentation and artefact. |
| | From week 3 onwards, Year 7 will be completing the Amazing Game unit of work. This is an exciting new course of study into the world of Digital Technology. Students will work in groups in a travel game format as they complete challenges, collect and analyse data and finally design and build a travel game app. | Week 7-11 - Digital technology comic strip and travel game app. |
| TECHNOLOGY Home Economics | For the first few weeks of the term students will continue with their experience in both Food and Textiles Technology. The remainder of the year they will be starting a new unit of work called "The Amazing Game" which is based on the TV series "The amazing race" Students will work as a team with challenges that relate to their learning of Digital Technology. They will race around the world as they learn new skills like designing an app for a game that could be played whilst waiting for a plane. (a novel idea at this time of no travel) This unit of work will continue in Term 1 next year. | There will be activities that students will need to complete during the game so they can move forward. |
| PDHPE | PE – We will be planning Covid Safe physical activities as per the current guidelines Health - starting a new unit "All for one and one for all" which covers the key concepts of inclusiveness and connectedness. | Class based activities. |

| MUSIC | Topic: Songwriting Basics (Learning music with Ableton) Students learn about the different elements of composing & performing popular music.
