<p>TECHNOLOGY MANDATORY–</p> <p>Home Economics</p>	<p>Half of all Year 7 classes will be studying Technology Mandatory with the Home Economics faculty in Semester 1 and in Semester 2 with Industrial Arts.</p> <p>In Home Economics students will be completing two units of work over the semester:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Food and Agriculture</li> <li>● Materials (Textiles).</li> </ul> <p>Food and Agriculture focuses on the theme of 'Farm to Fork'. In the Food and Agriculture area students will develop and produce a Noodle dish that can be sold at the school canteen and uses a herb. Students will research aspects of the agriculture industry in Australia.</p> <p>In Technology Materials (Textiles) students will have the opportunity to learn new practical textile skills by utilising some/all recycled material and producing a pair of shorts. Sustainability is an important factor in the textile industry and our society. Students will be incorporating some recycled materials in the completed boxer shorts.</p> <p>A folio will be produced that shows fashion concepts and visualisations as well as research on sustainability and ethical issues pertaining to Textiles.</p>	<p>Food and Agriculture (Food to Fork)</p> <p>Written work in their design folio and booklet.</p> <p>In practical lessons at school students are required to bring a tea towel, dish cloth, a container for the prepared food and a plastic bag for the wet tea towel and dish cloth.</p> <p>Materials (Textiles)</p> <p>Practical lessons at school, Written work in their design folio and booklet.</p> <p>Fabric may be purchased from Home Economics for \$15.</p>

PDHPE	<p>Year 7 will have 2 lessons of PE and 1 lesson for Health each fortnight.</p> <p>Students need to wear or bring their PE uniform to get changed for their PE lessons.</p> <p>In Health, Year 7 will be studying the unit “You’ve Changed”, which includes adolescent health changes.</p> <p>In PE, they will be studying the unit “Let’s Move” which includes movement composition, Dance, Gymnastics, Fitness and Cardiovascular activities.</p>	<p>Year 7 will have a theory assessment task called “Dr Help” which looks at help seeking behaviours. They will also be completing a group movement composition task and a fitness assignment.</p>
SPORT	<p>Year 7 will be participating in Sport as a year group on Thursday mornings. They are to wear their PE/Sport uniform to school on Thursdays with the rest of the school. They will be participating in team sports, learning as they play.</p> <p>School/zone/regional carnivals, knockout sports and zone/regional representative sport trials are held during Term 1. Students are to check their emails and listen to the announcements for specific details.</p>	<p>The school Swimming Carnival will be held on Friday 11 February 2022 for all of Year 7 to attend.</p>
Visual Arts	<p>Students will be studying artmaking, the elements of art, still life and creating a small drawing.</p>	<p>Practical Task</p> <p>Writing tasks</p>
Music	<p>Students will be exploring the basics of music notation through performing a popular song on Melodica in the unit ‘All you need to know to be a rockstar’. In the second half of the term students will explore the building blocks of electronic music.</p>	<p>Students will perform a song on melodica in week 6.</p>
